League Rules and Regulations for 2020 Season

1. TEAM ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

- Cost of league play is \$20.00 per person (\$15.00 for members) per night. Paid at entry that night.
- Each team member must be at least 14 years of age prior to the teams 1st scheduled game.
- Each team will determine the team's name
- Each team will be comprised of three (3) team members.
- Players may not play for more than one team in the same league.
- Players may use their own firearms up to .45 cal. (Handguns only)
- Players may shoot reloads if approved by LARGC.

2. TEAM CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for players attendance for game night.
- Responsible for notifying team members of any schedule changes.

3. TEAM ROSTER INFORMATION

- A team must have a minimum of 3 players
- Substitutions may be done night of game with notification given to LARGC.
- Players that are ejected from the league may not be replaced on the team roster.
- Once a player has played for a team, he/she may not move to another team.

4. GAME MODIFICATIONS

- Each game consists of a course designed by LARGC and design will change week to week.
- Course will consist of multiple stations with IPSC style targets
- Score will be on an average of time and accuracy
- Time and score will be kept by LARGC RSO
- Any ruling dispute will be resolved between captains and RSO

5. SPORTSMANSHIP

• LARGC observes a NO TOLERANCE policy. Players and spectators are expected to act in a sportsmanlike manner toward other players, spectators and the LARGC staff. Players and spectators who fail to abide by this policy will be asked to leave the facility.

6. REGULAR SEASON INFORMATION

- The league will consist of two (2) divisions. A minimum of six (6) teams is required, three (3) teams per division for league play.
- If a regular season game is canceled for any reason, LARGC will attempt to reschedule the game; but is not required to reschedule the game.
- Schedule will be published when teams are decided.
- Teams will be given a league schedule via captains. If there is a change in the league schedule, team captains will be notified within 24 hours of the change.
- Teams are only guaranteed to be scheduled a certain number of games.
- All team members must attend games when schedule or will be subject to forfeit.
- The League is not responsible for forfeited games and will not reschedule forfeited games.

7. POST-SEASON TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- There will be a single elimination tournament after the conclusion of the regular season, final determination will be of first and second place division leaders.
- Final four will compete in a bracket style tournament.

8. TIE-BREAKERS

• Tie-Breakers are determined by one single shot from the captain at firing line to a silhouette target closest to center.

9. INJURIES AND LIABILITY

- All injuries should be reported to the on-site RSO immediately, so appropriate actions may be taken.
- Any injury that requires any form of first aid provided by the supervisor will require documentation. Participants are required to assist and cooperate in this process.
- Any injuries that require immediate medical attention will be treated as such. Participants may have the option to leave with the assistance of a teammate, who will accept responsibility for your care; or LARGC will call for further assistance.

10. MISCELLANEOUS

- Spectators may view games in progress from behind established firing line only.
- Participants damaging LARGC property maybe subject to fines and may be permanently banned from the League.
- The League Director reserves the right to modify, or make changes to league schedules, rules, policy & procedures, etc., with the responsibility of informing team captains of the changes.
